

## REQUIREMENTS FOR MENTEES / SUPPLIER QUALIFICATIONS APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED IN ITS ENTIRETY AND SIGNED TO BE ACCEPTED FINAL APPLICATION DUE FEBRUARY 21 • APPLICANTS NOTIFIED BY MARCH 28

## Applicant must:

- 1. Be the CEO, Owner, Managing Partner or President of the company. No Exceptions!
- 2. Be a paid, active DA4S Member
- 3. Applicant must understand if accepted into this program, they must make the program a business priority. This includes being responsive and prepared to be fully engaged with their Mentor and the committee
- 4. Agree to attend the 2025 and 2026 East Conference and 2025 West Coast conference
- 5. Agree to sponsor one DA4S event. Either West Coast 2025 or East Coast 2026 if accepted into program
- 6. Maintain a paid, active membership for 2025, 2026 and 2027. Membership dues for 2026 and 2027 (a total of \$2,200) must be paid by July 1, 2025. No exceptions.
- 7. Be in business a minimum of three years. (DA4S may consider application if 2+ years)
- 8. Commit to the time requirements needed to implement the mentoring plan with assigned mentor and at least 2 hours per week throughout the duration of the program
- 9. Commit to attending the following mentorship meetings (in-person if required):
  - a) East Coast Conference April 29-May 1
  - b) Mentorship Program Welcome (April 29 at East Coast Conference)
  - c) Mentorship Program Virtual Kick-Off Meeting (June 2)
  - d) Regular Check-In Calls with the Mentorship Committee Virtual
  - e) West Coast Conference (September 9-11)
  - f) Pitch Competition at the 2026 East Coast Conference
- 10. Submit this completed application along with a professional photo. All items must be submitted together. Every applicant must have a professional high-resolution photo. This is not optional. Do not submit your application without a photo
- 11. Accept & sign Waiver of Liability and Program Expectation Terms
- 12. Applicant may participate in the Mentorship Program a maximum of two years (can be consecutive)
- 13. Confirm that Company is in a fiscally sound position (if not then please do not apply)
- 14. Must participate (not optional) in a virtual interview on March 6 & 7. Applicant will be interviewed with the corporate mentors. More information will be provided. The interview day is a requirement to be considered for selection. Date will be provided and applicant must make themselves available

## **Program Commitments for Mentor & Mentee**

- 1. One year starting in June 2025 and ending May 2026
- 2. Exclusive Kick-off Meeting on April 29, 2025 at the East Coast Conference
- 3. Regular Mentorship check-in calls (June 2025-April 2026). These calls are separate from the Mentee/Mentor meetings and mentee must attend. Dates are provided in advance for planning
- 4. In-person meetings are suggested if possible, but at minimum virtual monthly meetings are required for Mentor/Mentee pairs within the course of this program. (Pairs schedule this according to their calendars)
- 5. Goals to be met during program. (Goals are discussed and set by each pair)
- 6. Each mentee will be assigned a "buddy" from the committee. It is expected that they communicate <u>timely</u> with them. This is not optional

## Framework – Quarterly + Deliverables

- 1. June July: Finalize objectives, submit goals, schedule initial meeting during this time-frame, plan out meetings for the rest of the year
- 2. August November: Share progress with Mentorship committee
- 3. January April: Share progress Prepare to finalize open actions
- 4. April May: Close-out plan; Turn in final goals and complete survey for Mentorship Metrics; Participate in pitch competition; Submit written testimonial

Failure to meet any of these requirements, expectations and deliverables during the program <u>will</u> result in Mentee being removed from the program. Mentorship Program is not to gain business from a Mentoring Company. Asking your Mentor for business will result in an immediate dismissal from the program. Once committed to the program, mentee agrees to complete the one-year program. If mentee withdraws they acknowledge that their membership fees are non-refundable and they will not be eligible to reapply in the future.
